_____ You must give leadership to others.

_____ Project must not be a usual job or service.

_____ Project may not be on Boy Scout property or for a Boy Scout program.

_____ Project may not be for a business, or a commercial nature, or be a fundraiser.

_____ Fundraising is permitted for materials or supplies to carry out the project.

_____ Project must be helpful to a religious institution, a school, or a community.

_____ You must answer the following questions:

- Who will benefit?
- How will they benefit?
- What person from the benefiting group will offer guidance?
- How many people will you recruit to complete the project?

_____ Service project must be approved by your leader, unit committee, and district advancement chair before you start.

_____ When the service project is done, the Service Project Workbook must be fully and accurately completed. Be sure to include the following:

- How you demonstrated leadership of others.
- How you were the project director rather than a worker.
- How the project helped the group.
- Did the project follow the plan? If changes were made, why?
